Prepared in partnership between the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) and the South Carolina Division of the Federal Highway Commission (FHWA), the coffee-table style book follows the state's single largest transportation infrastructure project through its planning, design, community outreach, and construction to its 2005 opening. With almost 200 color photos, dozens of first person interviews, and even a short history of the Grace and Pearman Bridges, the books are a perfect gift for those who love history, bridges, engineering, construction, Charleston, and South Carolina.
